## **Consortium Agreement Terms and Conditions**

#### **Background**

Students pursuing a degree or certificate at North Seattle College may only receive financial aid from North. However, sometimes a student is unable to take certain courses at North and will need to take required courses for their program of study at a different school (the Host school). In these cases, a consortium agreement allows students to get financial aid at North for classes taken at the Host School. If approved, a student could receive financial aid for the total number of credits at both schools. Please note: even with an approved Consortium Agreement, the student is required to pay for classes themselves at the Host School.

#### Requirements

To be eligible to receive a consortium agreement for a specific quarter, the following requirements must be met:

- 1. The courses you take at the Host School must satisfy program requirements that you have not already met and must be transferable to your program at North Seattle College.
- 2. The courses you take at the Host School are either:
  - a. Not offered at North Seattle College for the particular quarter; or
  - b. Are offered for the particular quarter, but the class time(s) conflict with other courses you wish to take.
- 3. You must be concurrently enrolled for at least one course at North Seattle College in addition to a course(s) at the host college. For loans you must be in at least six (6) credits between both colleges.
- 4. You must pay for classes yourself at the Host School, even with an approved Consortium Agreement.
- 5. You must be awarded financial aid, not just have a completed application.
- 6. You must submit a copy of an unofficial grade transcript from your host school at the end of the quarter.

### **Application Process**

If the credits you are interested in taking at another school meet the requirements listed above, you can apply for a consortium agreement. The application steps are as follows:

- 1. Complete the "Consortium Agreement Request Form" on the reverse side of this document.
- 2. Ask your Academic Advisor at North Seattle College to complete their sections of the application.
- 3. Attach a copy of your course registration from the Host School and North Seattle College.
- 4. Submit the completed application to the Financial Aid Office at North Seattle College.

#### **Deadline**

To avoid delays in receiving your financial aid, it is strongly recommended that you submit the completed application to the Financial Aid Office at North Seattle College at least three (3) weeks prior to the start of the quarter, **but no later than the 10th day of the quarter.** 

#### **Student Notification**

North Seattle College will notify via email as to whether or not your consortium agreement application has been approved with instructions and responsibilities. If your consortium agreement is approved, you must submit a copy of an unofficial grade transcript from your host school at the end of the quarter <u>AND</u> have credits officially transferred for evaluation evaluated within eight (8) weeks of course completion. Subsequent quarters of financial aid will be in a hold status until Host School transcripts are submitted.
