


Step by Step Guide Applying for College Admission

If at any time you run into difficulty, reach out to the following: <u>NSCAdmissions@seattlecolleges.edu</u> OR <u>NSCRegistration@seattlecolleges.edu</u>

If you have participated in Running Start at North Seattle College, you won't need to apply for college admission. However, if you participated in Running Start or College in the High School at different college, you'll need to apply.

Creating Your Account

Log in to the Washington State Free Online Application <u>at this link</u> or go to <u>www.northseattle.edu</u> and click on *Apply Now* at the top of the page. (The URL for this link is listed at the bottom of this document.) Create an account using the link on the landing page shown below. *Be sure to write down your username and password!*



Unfortunately, creating your account is a rather lengthy process with lots of steps. Here is an outline of the steps you'll need to follow:

- Click on the Create an account link (shown above).
- Create a username and password.

Write your username and password down so you can access your application later if needed.

• Fill out the Other Information (name, date of birth, email address) then click Submit.

Important! Don't use your Seattle Public Schools email address as it will block information you'll need from the state to register.

- Fill out the security questions when prompted, select "I am not a robot" and click Submit.
- A pop-up window will appear prompting you to enter a one-time password (OTP). This OTP will be sent to the email address you provided in the previous step. Find the OTP/Code in your email and enter it in the pop-up window. Click on *Submit OTP*. (The email with the OTP, usually a numeric code, will be from the address <u>noreply@sbctc.edu</u>.)

• You should now see the log-in prompt shown below. Here's where you'll use the username and password you created at the beginning of this process.



Step 1 – Start a New Application Page

You're *finally* ready to create your admissions application. After you log in, you'll be taken to the *Start a New Application* page.

These are the answers you should use on this page:

Answer the questions on the Personal Information page as appropriate. This page includes some pull-down menus and blanks for you to type your information. You only need to answer items with the * mark. On this page, the only thing you are required to add is your address.

When finished with this page, click NEXT on the lower right corner of the page or save for later.

Step 3 – High School Information

After you click NEXT on the Personal Information Page, you'll be taken to High School Information Page. Click on *Search High School* and a new dialogue box opens (shown below). Type in the name of your high school and options will appear. Click the link that represents your high school.


After you select the link that corresponds to your high school, the window closes and you'll see that your school's information has been entered (shown below).

We're not quite done with the high school page. Next, add the date you began high school. You don't need to know the exact day. You can select a day in August or September. If you pick a day that is on a Saturday or Sunday, you'll get a red error message. For the end date, select the current day.

Finally, select your <u>current grade</u> from the drop-down menu when asked, "What will be the highest level of completion when you begin college?" If you are in 12th grade, select *High School Diploma*. Look for the little arrow on the far right side of the page to find the drop-down menu (shown below). Click NEXT or save for later.

Step 4 - Ethnicity

Complete the Ethnicity Information page next. (This is not required but helps the college with planning and support services.) When finished, select NEXT or save for later.

Fill this out and when finished select NEXT or save for later. (On this page, every answer is in a drop-down menu. Look for the little arrow on the right side of the page.) You need to answer every question, but you may select *Prefer not to answer* from the list of options.

What Happens Next?

After the end of the application period (September 25 – October 6), you'll receive your student ID number (ctcLink ID number) via email. This will be a 9-digit number, likely beginning with 202. Be sure to write this down. You'll need this later to sign up for class. This step only admits you to the college. If you don't receive your number in a few days, be sure to check your junk folder OR log back into your application and the number should be on the top of the screen.
