

UNDERAGE ADMISSION PROCESS

Applications for Underage Admission will be accepted from students who fall into the following categories:

- Under 18 years of age
- Have attained at least high school junior standing
- Have not completed High School or a GED
- Are not enrolled in Running Start

Underage Exception to Policy Application:

All students who do fall under the above listed requirements must complete the following steps prior to being considered for an admissions exception:

- 1. Complete a North Seattle College Application for Admission Form online: <u>https://northseattle.edu/admissions-application</u>.
 - a) You will be emailed a student identification number (ctcLink ID) which will be needed in order to take any placement assessments. Keep all other required information (below) together until you meet with the Underage Advisor as part of step 6.
- 2. All underage applicants are required to have English or math placement. Math placement is required for math and some science classes. Once you've received your ctcLink ID number, check the Testing webpage to learn about documents accepted for placement and placement tool options: https://northseattle.edu/placement-tests.
- 3. Obtain an **<u>unofficial</u>** transcript from your high school.
- 4. Write a letter explaining, in detail, the reason for requesting permission to be admitted as an underage student.
- 5. Get school and parent/guardian permission:
 - a) Your high school counselor or designee must provide a letter indicating the recommended college class(es) and reasons for the recommendation(s). If you are home schooled, have your district's Home School Resource Office or designated authority provide the letter of recommendation.
 - b) Complete the Underage Permission Form (page 2 of this document), obtaining signatures from the high school counselor and parent/guardian.

Note: Students planning to earn a high school diploma from NSC must obtain a <u>written</u> <u>release</u> to attend NSC from the Student Placement Office of Seattle Public Schools (or if not within Seattle Public Schools area, from your high school principal)

6. Make an appointment to meet with the underage advisor in the Advising Office by calling (206) 934-7768 or emailing nscrstart@seattlecolleges.edu.

NOTE: If you are admitted to the college, it will be on a **quarterly basis**. You will be expected to make <u>satisfactory progress</u> in your course(s) to continue at the school as an underage student for subsequent quarters. **The Underage Student Permission form must be completed before registration each quarter.**
