Applying for Admission to North Seattle College



Who Needs to Apply?

If you have participated in Running Start at North Seattle College (or another College in the High School (CHS) Course at NSC), you won't need to apply for college admission. However, if you participated in Running Start of CHS at another college, you will need to complete this process and apply for admission to North Seattle.

Steps for Creating Your Account

- Click on the Create an account link shown on the previous slide.
- Create a username and password.

Write your username and password down (or put it in your phone) so you can access your application later if needed.

• Fill out the Other Information items (name, date of birth, email address) then click Submit.

Important! Don't use your Seattle Public Schools email address as it may block information you'll need from the state in order to sign up for class.

Fill out the security questions when prompted, select "I am not a robot" and click Submit.




Creating Your Account – The OTP

A pop-up window will appear prompting you to enter a one-time password (OTP). This OTP will be sent to the email address you provided in the previous step. Find the OTP/Code in your email and enter it in the pop-up window. Click on Submit OTP. (The email with the OTP, usually a numeric code, will be from the address noreply@sbctc.edu.)



You should now see the log-in prompt shown here. Click on *Log in Here* and use the username and password you just created.





Application - Step 1

You are finally ready to create your admissions application. After you log in, you'll be taken to the Start a New Application page. Here are the answers you should use on this page.

- College: select North Seattle College
- I will be enrolling as: select First Year
- Program: select Transitional Studies
- Term: select Winter 2024 for Fall Semester or Year-Long classes or Spring 2024 for Spring Semester classes. (Check with your teacher for what you should select.)
- Degree or Certificate: select Undecided-Trans Studies. Skip the Academic Focus Area question.

Click on *Apply* when finished.



Application Step 2 – Personal Information


- Answer the questions on the Personal Information page as appropriate. This
 page includes some pull-down menus and some blank spaces for you to type
 your information.
- You only need to answer items with the * mark (shown in red on the application).
 On this page, the only thing you are required to add is your address.
- When finished with this page, click NEXT on the lower right corner of the page or save for later.





Application Step 3 – High School Information

 After you click NEXT on the Personal Information Page, you'll be taken to the High School Information Page. Click on Search High School and a new dialogue box opens. Type in the name of your high school and options will appear. Click the link that represents your school.





 After you select the link that corresponds to your high school, the dialogue box closes and you'll see that your school information has been entered.

You're not quite done with the high school page. To finish this page:

- Add the date you began high school. You don't need to know the exact day. You can select a day in August or September. If you pick a Saturday or Sunday, you'll get a red error message. Pick another date.
- For the end date, select the current day.
- Finally, select your <u>current grade</u> from the drop-down menu when asked, "What will be the highest level of completion when you begin college?" If you are in 12th grade, select *High School Diploma*. Look for the little arrow on the right side of the page to find the drop-down menu. Click NEXT or Save for Later.


What will your high school completion status be when you begin college? *





Application Step 4 – Ethnicity

Complete the Ethnicity Information page. (This is not required but helps the college with planning and support services.) When finished, select NEXT or save for later.





Application Step 5 – Supplemental Questions


Answer the questions on this page. Every answer is in a drop-down menu. Look for the little arrow on the right side of the page. You need to answer every question, but you may select *Prefer not to answer* from the list of options. Click NEXT or save for later.

Review and Submit

This is the last step. Read the text and click on the box next to "Yes, I accept." Finally, select Submit Now and you are done!





What Happens Next?

After the end of the application period, you'll receive your student ID number (ctcLink ID number) via email. This will be a 9-digit number, likely beginning with 203. Be sure to write this down. You'll need this later to sign up for class. This step only admits you to the college. If you don't receive your number in a few days, be sure to check your junk folder OR log back into your application and the number should be on the top of the screen.

NOTE: This process admits you as a student of North Seattle College. It doesn't sign you up for your College in the High School course. That will happen later; your teacher will help you through the process.
