SEATTLE PACIFIC UNIVERSITY

Application deadline for transfer applicants: Jan 15 for Fall and Winter.

Two different applications must be submitted: ONE to Seattle Pacific University and ONE to the School of Health Sciences.

• At least 90 transferable credits must be completed by June of the application year. Also, it is recommended that students who have never taken courses at SPU complete an Associate DTA (e.g., AA-DTA, AS-DTA).

- Four of the nursing prerequisites must be completed by the application deadline. All prerequisites must be completed by the end of spring quarter of the application year.
- Transfer students must have a minimum 3.5 GPA in their nursing prerequisite courses to apply. However, meeting this GPA standard does not guarantee admission to the program, as the total number of admitted students may be limited by capacity.

SEATTLE UNIVERSITY

Application deadline: <u>December 1</u> for Autumn admission to BSN.

- A transferrable Associate of Arts degree, previous bachelor's degree, or at least 90 or more quarter credits, including a 5-credit hands on art course, must be completed by the start of the program.
- Students must obtain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and nursing prerequisite GPA of 3.0 to apply to the nursing program.
- Applicants must complete 7 of the 10 prerequisite courses, including at least one anatomy/physiology or microbiology course AND one math prerequisite, by the application deadline.
- Science and statistics coursework must be completed within 5 years of the anticipated program start date, and math, psychology, and nutrition must be completed within 10 years. One hands-on Art class required.
- No more than two prerequisite courses may be repeated. This excludes courses repeated due to timespan requirements.

UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON – SEATTLE

Application Deadline: January 15 for autumn admission to BSN. February 15 for autumn admission to UW.

Two different applications must be submitted: ONE to the University of Washington and ONE to the School of Nursing. UW Admissions: (206) 543-9686 http://admit.washington.edu/

- Applicants must complete at least 90 college quarter credits of prerequisite courses by the start of the program. Application requires a minimum of 3 Natural World prerequisite courses (i.e., general chemistry, organic chemistry, microbiology, anatomy and physiology, nutrition), with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA OR 4 prerequisite Natural World courses, with a minimum 2.8 cumulative GPA.
- A minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA is required, and a minimum grade of 2.0 for each prerequisite course is required.
- Applicants are expected to have 100 hours of volunteer or paid health care experience in one setting for a minimum of three months. The majority of applicants have several hundred hours of health care experience for nine months or more.
