

During the current academic year, nearly four in ten respondents (38.0 %) indicated they either "moderately" or "strongly" agreed they had had opportunities to provide feedback to North Seattle College regarding incidents of racism, while over three in ten respondents (34.2 %) indicated they either "moderately" or "strongly agreed" that the College had taken appropriate action regarding these incidents of racism .
